Privacy Policy

How Skipton Building Society will use, share and keep your personal information.

When a nomination is submitted to the Community Giving awards scheme, Skipton Building Society collects personal data about the nominee and the nominated charity/ community group. This includes what the funds will be used for, which helps us decide which causes will receive a donation.

When we refer to 'we', 'our', 'us', 'Skipton' and the 'Society' we mean Skipton Building Society.

We, Skipton Building Society, are the data controller responsible for the safe keeping of your personal data which will be used:

- to administer the awards scheme and notify the nominees and applicants by email of the outcome
- · to understand who is making the nomination
- to contact the nominator or charity/community group with any queries
- to undertake checks on the nominators firm and the nominee as part of the selection process on the basis that we have a legitimate interest in preventing fraud and money laundering, and to verify identity, in order to protect our business and to comply with laws that apply to us.

This Data Privacy Notice does not extend to any external websites accessed from our website, including sites that are available from other members of the Skipton Building Society Group.

Successful causes and nominator's will be asked for permission to use:

- a photograph/testimonial of the charity/community group
- nominator's name and details and nomination information.

Before providing consent we kindly request that your nominee ensures any individuals featured in the photograph have also consented to the use of their image. Where permission is provided, these will be used as part of our marketing promotions such as email communications and on our website, for up to 12 months following the announcement.

Consent may be withdrawn at any time by contacting the Community Giving Mailbox (communitygiving@skipton. co.uk) Should consent be withdrawn, we will remove mentions and media from our owned websites and social media channels to the extent that we have control.

Retention of records

We will keep all nominations for six months. Successful nominations will be retained for 12 months for promotional purposes and to monitor how the charity/community group has benefited from the award. Where consent has been provided to use photography/testimonials, the data will remain in existing publications and on our social media and website, but will not be reused after 12 months from 13 September 2021.
